Any variations or claims of equality or superiority must be demonstrated, proven and tested to the satisfaction of ABI. **A signed copy of this addendum must be submitted with your response as confirmation of your receipt.**

Modification to Scope of Services:**Site #1- Mariposa Lofts**

- The source for the boulders at Mariposa Lofts is Silvara Stone, 931-484-6653 phone; contact: Jon Kraus
- When installing boulders at Mariposa Lofts, coordinate with Mariposa Lofts Management office prior to commencing work.

Site #2- Private Drive behind Parish Restaurant

- The source for the boulders at the private drive behind Parish Restaurant is Silvara Stone, 931-484-6653 phone; contact: Jon Kraus

Site #4- Historic Fourth Ward Park Skatepark (H4WP)

- The updated source contact information for the bollard at Historic Fourth Ward Skatepark is D&D Fabrication, 770-241-8653 phone; contact: Wesley Dillard
- Bollard at Site for Historic Fourth Ward Skatepark shall be offset from the center of the trail to allow wheelchair access.

Site #5- North of Ponce de Leon Avenue, bridge

- At North of Ponce de Leon Avenue (bridge), Trees Atlanta will clear the necessary vegetation to accommodate guardrail installation.

Construction staging is allowable in the corridor under Freedom Parkway (near H4WP Skatepark).

Where topsoil is brought in, soil stabilization shall be the responsibility of Trees Atlanta as part of their follow- on planting in scope of work.

2. Original survey sheets of the Eastside Trail from 2011 and EST Lighting plans have been provided at <https://beltline.org/rfps-and-rfgs/corridor-edges-security-enhancements/> as reference. Receipt of these plans do not override the requisite 811 utility mark-out.

Questions/Answers:

1. **QUESTION:** Are there any plans and specs available?

ANSWER: No construction drawings have been prepared, but a standard detail for the Cor-Tenn guardrail has been included as part of this addendum at <https://beltline.org/rfps-and-rfgs/corridor-edges-security-enhancements/>. Confirm with the fabricator for any revisions to their standard detail prior to pricing. Quantities, sizes, etc. of required elements (boulders, guardrail, topsoil, bollards) have been provided within the solicitation and in Addendum #1.

2. **QUESTION:** What is the LF quantity for the Cor-Tenn Guardrail at King of Pops?

ANSWER: Guardrail is required on both the west and east sides of the trail entrance from Bernina Ave. The west side is +/- 160 LF; east side is +/-50 LF.

3. **QUESTION:** Do you have an updated phone number for D&D Fabrication? The number listed in the ITB is not correct.

ANSWER: D&D Fabrication can be reached at (770) 241-8653. Wesley Dillard is the contact.

4. **QUESTION:** How were the boulder firms listed in the ITB selected?

ANSWER: For past projects, Silvara was a “one stop shop” for very large stones and to maintain consistency.



5. **QUESTION:** Firm(s) outside of the State of Georgia are listed in the ITB for boulder sourcing. Are there any other boulder firms located in the State of Georgia that can be contacted to source boulders or can we contact firms located in Georgia?

ANSWER: Alternate sources may be submitted for approval. However, ABI must visit the alternate source to approve stones prior to delivery.
