1. **QUESTION:** What is prompting the need to update the SIP at this moment; has there been a milestone reached or another trigger to motivate this RFP?

ANSWER: ABI seeks to create an effective plan for the final 10 years of the Tax Allocation District that addresses challenges in our transit, trail, parks, housing, and economic development programs. The SIP update will also focus on identifying additional funding and updating budgets required for the real estate acquisition, design, and construction needed to complete the Atlanta BeltLine infrastructure. The SIP update will incorporate studies, new and/or refreshed data, new project initiatives, updated subarea masterplans and other pertinent information that has been completed/compiled during the period following the original SIP.

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2. **QUESTION:** What is the approximate budget or level of effort sought for the SIP update?

ANSWER: Proposal costs are negotiable between ABI and the apparent successful offeror. The level of effort is defined in the RFP and may also shift according to negotiations. ABI is seeking a proposal that will utilize the existing SIP to complete a robust update.

3. **QUESTION:** Does ABI have a preference for the type of firm who would lead the project (e.g., an urban planning firm, an architecture firm, etc.)?
